

## Modify NOR 8 - Programme on Saturday 6th November:

Saturday 6th November	
<b>0900 (UTC)</b> 1000 local time	Start Briefing. Mandatory attendance of both skippers. (Place: Carré des Docks / C400). <b>Mandatory attendance of at least 1 skipper in the race village until 1500 UTC</b>

## Modify the last paragraph of NOR 8.1 (Programme in Le Havre):

There will be a collaborative prologue during the 'Try Sailing' sessions organised from Friday 29th October to Saturday 6th November, **the details of which will be defined in the Sailing Instructions**

At least 1 skipper per boat shall take part in at least one 'Try Sailing' session. These sessions will take place on the Bassin de l'Eure on Bénéteau FC 7.5s with the aim of introducing sailing to a wide range of people. The sessions last 20 – 30 minutes and take place every day from 0900 UTC (1000 local time) to 1600 UTC (1700 local time) except on the Thursday. Each skipper shall voluntarily put in an appearance at the "Animations Nautiques", at Quai Renaud, to take part in the initiation.

## Add to NOR 9 (Mandatory crew attendance):

9.4 A skipper who does not wish to take part in a mandatory event in an enclosed space may submit a request for dispensation to Race Management, except for briefings and the E-prologue, where public health measures and social distancing will be applied.

## Modify NOR 6.3.9 (COVID-19: Participating in the race):

To ensure the safety of competitors, and in conjunction with the federal medical committee, there will be an enhanced health protocol. In any case, **each competitor must comply with the conditions required to obtain a health certificate ("pass sanitaire") at the start, and therefore must present one of the following:**

- **Proof of full vaccination**
- **A certificate proving recovery from Covid-19, dated at least 11 days earlier and less than 6 months old**
- **A negative PCR test of less than 72 h before the start.**

This **test protocol** simplifies operations for the MRCC (a contact case in a rescue team results in the team having to self-isolate for 5 days, thereby diluting maritime safety resources).

**The OA will do everything possible to facilitate taking this test.** The cost of this test will be borne by competitors.

If a competitor tests positive, the entire team must self-isolate. The competitor concerned must take a second PCR test 24 hours later. If this second test is negative, the requirement to isolate will be lifted and taking part in the race will be permitted. If the test result is positive, the **whole race team the boat** will be required to retire from the race.
